The missions chapels that are administrated from Our Lady of Guadalupe are: San Miguel Arcángel (San Miguel, N.M) Sagrada Familia (Lobatos, CO) St. Antonio de Padua (San Antonio, San Rafael (San Rafael, CO) San Juan Nepomuceno (Ortiz, CO) San Isidro Labrador (Las Mesitas, CO)

These missions and sub-communities would grow and practice within the protective shadow of the main church in Conejos.
